

KU TPE Application Planning & Checklist

This document provides application guidance for prospective students applying to KU Transition to Postsecondary Education.

It is recommended to submit disability and IEP documentation **prior to completing the applications below** since this determines eligibility. Please email documentation to kutpe@ku.edu or mail to the Program Coordinator at:

Be sure to have all reference letters and transcripts ready to upload as you complete the online applications. We do not accept these materials via email. The KU Application can be saved and completed in parts. The KU TPE Part 2 Application **must** be completed at one time as you will not be able to log back in to complete any portions.

Students should write the essay questions on the KU TPE application using their own skills and words. Admission decisions are not made on grammar, spelling, etc. It is important that they complete their own application. It is helpful to type it in a Word document first, and then copy/paste the text into the application.
